Submit "snippets"

Things you might submit:

Submission deadlines

The spring/summer edition:

- > Content to be included should be defined by January 1
- > Final submissions should be in by March 1
- > Editing must be complete by March 15
- > The magazine is sent to the printers March 31
- > The magazine is distributed in mid-late April

The fall/winter edition:

- > Content to be included should be defined by July 1
- > Final submissions should be in by September 1
- > Editing must be complete by September 15
- > The magazine is sent to the printers September 30
- > The magazine is distributed in mid-late October
